BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 27(1)(b) read with Section 25A of the Universities Act, No. 16 of 1978, I, Dr. A. D. Susil Premajayantha, the Minister of Education, having obtained a report under section 70C of the aforesaid Act, in respect of the National School of Business Management Limited (NSBM), a company incorporated in Sri Lanka under the Companies Act, No. 7 of 2007 and bearing registration number PB 4833, being recognized as a Degree Awarding Institute, do by this Order, amend the Schedule I and Schedule II to the Order made under the said Act, and published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 2224/26, of April 22, 2021 as follows:-

1. in condition 1 of the Schedule I, by the substitution for the degree name “Bachelor of Science Honours in Public Health and Nutrition”, of the degree name “Bachelor of Science Honours in Nutrition and Health”; and
2. by the substitution for the degree name “Bachelor of Science Honours Public Health and Nutrition” appearing in Column I of the Schedule II which corresponds to the abbreviations appearing in Column II of that Schedule, of the following degree name and abbreviations respectively:-

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 27(1)(b) read with Section 25A of the Universities Act, No. 16 of 1978, I, Dr. A. D. Susil Premajayantha, the Minister of Education, having obtained a report under section 70C of the aforesaid Act, in respect of the Institute of chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka (ICASL), established under the Institute of Chartered Accountants Act, No. 23 of 1959 and located at No. 30A, Malalasekara Mawatha, Colombo 7, being recognized as a Degree Awarding Institute, do by this Order, amend the Schedule II to the Order made under the said Act, and published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 2321/64 of March 02, 2023, by the addition immediately after the entry “Master of Public Financial Management” appearing in Column I and its corresponding entry in Column II thereof, of the entries specified under Column I and Column II respectively of the Schedule II hereto, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule I hereto.

SCHEDULE I

CONDITIONS

1. Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka (ICASL) shall, when admitting students for the degree programmes specified in Schedule II hereto in respect of the Bachelor of Management Honours in Business Analytics, complete with a minimum of 120 credits (SLQF level 6) and Bachelor of Management in Business Analytics, complete with a minimum of 90 credits (SLQF level 5), adhere to the minimum entry qualification of three (3) ‘simple passes’ (S) in any subject stream, in one and the same sitting at the GCE (Advanced Level) Examination conducted by the Department of Examinations of Sri Lanka or equivalent.
2. Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka (ICASL) is recognized to offer the degree specified in Schedule II hereto, subject to the five (5) year re-review conducted by the Specified Authority.
