THE UNIVERSITIES ACT, No. 16 OF 1978

Order under Section 25A

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 25 A of the Universities Act, No. 16 of 1978, I, Prof. G. L. Peiris, the Minister of Education having obtained a report under Section 70C of the aforesaid Act, in respect of the Sri Lanka International Buddhist Academy, a company incorporated in Sri Lanka under the Companies Act, No. 7 of 2007 and bearing Registration Number GA 2232, being recognized as a Degree Awarding Institute, do by this Order amend the Schedule II to the Order made under the said Act and published in *Gazette Extraordinary*, No. 1979/21 of August 9, 2016, by the addition immediately after the entry “Bachelor of Technology in Information Technology and Communication” appearing in Column I and its abbreviation appearing in the corresponding entry in Column II thereof, of the entries specified under Column I and II respectively in the Schedule II hereto, subject to the conditions specified in the Schedule I hereto:-

SCHEDULE 1

Conditions

1. In respect of the course of study titled Bachelor of Business Management (Honours) (SLQF Level 6), the minimum entry qualification for admitting a student shall be -



- (i) three (03) Simple Passes (S) in the Commerce subject stream in one and the same sitting at GCE (Advanced Level) Examination conducted by the Department of Examinations of Sri Lanka or equivalent; or
 - (ii) three (03) Simple Passes (S) in any subject stream in one and the same sitting at GCE (Advanced/Level) Examination conducted by the Department of Examinations of Sri Lanka with a bridging course approved by the Specified Authority.
2. In respect of the Bachelor of Performing Arts Honours in Kandyan Dance (SLQF Level 6), the minimum entry qualification for admitting a student shall be three (03) simple passes (S) in Arts Stream in one and the same sitting at GCE (Advanced Level) Examination conducted by the Department of Examinations of Sri Lanka or equivalent qualification.
 3. Every five (5) years from the date of publication of this Order a Subject Re-review shall be conducted by the Specified Authority in order to offer the degrees specified in the Schedule II.

Order under section 25A

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 25A of the Universities Act, No. 16 of 1978, I, Prof. G. L. Peiris, the Minister of Education having obtained a report under Section 70C of the aforesaid Act, in respect of the SLT Campus (Private) Limited, a company incorporated in Sri Lanka under the Companies Act, No. 7 of 2007 and bearing Registration Number PV 101137, being recognized as a Degree Awarding Institute, do by this Order amend the Schedule II to the Order made under the said Act and published in *Gazette* Extraordinary, No. 2164/54 of February 27, 2020 by the addition immediately after the entry "Bachelor of Science Honours in Bio Systems Engineering" appearing in Column I and its corresponding entry in Column II thereof, of the entries specified under Column I and II respectively in the Schedule II hereto, subject to such conditions as specified in Schedule I hereto:-

SCHEDULE I

Conditions

1. In respect of the course of study titled the Bachelor of Science Honours in Data Science (SLQF level 6), Bachelor of Science Honours in Cloud Computing (SLQF level 6), Bachelor of Science Honours in Software Engineering (SLQF level 6) and Bachelor of Science Honours in Cyber Security (SLQF level 6), the minimum entry qualification for admitting a student shall be -
 - (i) three (03) simple passes (S) in the Physical Science subject stream in one and the same sitting at GCE (Advanced Level) Examination conducted by the Department of Examinations of Sri Lanka or equivalent qualification; or
 - (ii) three (03) simple passes (S) in any subject stream in one and the same sitting at GCE (Advanced Level) Examination conducted by the Department of Examinations of Sri Lanka with a bridging course approved by the Specified Authority.
2. In respect of the course of study titled the Bachelor of Science Honours in Engineering in Civil Engineering (SLQF level 6), adhere to the minimum entry qualification of three (03) simple passes (S) in Physics, Chemistry and Combined Mathematics in one and the same sitting at GCE (Advanced Level) Examination conducted by the Department of Examinations of Sri Lanka or equivalent qualification.
3. In respect of the course of study titled the Bachelor of Music Honours (SLQF level 6) adhere to the minimum entry qualification of three (03) simple passes (S) in any subject stream in one and the same sitting at GCE (Advanced Level) Examination conducted by the Department of Examinations of Sri Lanka or equivalent qualification.
4. Every five (5) years from the date of publication of this Order a Subject Re-review shall be conducted by the Specified Authority in order to offer the degrees specified in the Schedule II.
