**Indian Undergraduate Scholarships offered by Rajiv Gandhi
Scholarship Scheme – 2020/21**

Applications are invited from eligible Sri Lankan students for the award of undergraduate scholarships offered by the Government of India under the Rajiv Gandhi Scholarship Scheme for the academic year 2020/21.

Number of scholarships: 25

01. General Eligibility requirements: -

- (a) Should be a citizen of Sri Lanka.
- (b) Age should be below 22 years on **06.01.2020**
- (c) Students should have gained three passes in Math's Stream at the G.C.E. (A/L) Examination conducted by the Department of Examinations, Sri Lanka
- (d) Should possess a high proficiency in English. (Should have obtained a "C" pass in English at the G.C.E. (O/L) Examination and "S" pass at the G.C.E A/L Examination)
- (e) Should be in good health and ready to live in India during the period of study.
- (f) Applicant should not be already registered or following a course at a university in Sri Lanka as an internal student (a student selected by UGC based on the G.C.E. A/L results).

03. Field of Study

Engineering - Electrical, Electronics, Computer Science and Engineering, Civil Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering, Mechanical Engineering...etc.

- ❖ **The ICCR Scholarship council does not arrange admission in Medical/Dental/Paramedical (Nursing, Physiotherapy, anesthesia)/Fashion Design.**
- ❖ Field of study selected at the beginning will not be changed later under any circumstances.

04. Scholarship Benefits:

- A personal maintenance allowance
- Approved tuition and exam fees
- A grant for books and apparatus, where applicable
- Round Trip Air Ticket

05. Special Notes:

- (a) Candidates who are awarded a scholarship for undergraduate studies would not be considered for university admission process of the University Grants Commission.
- (b) Conditions laid down in this notification may vary as per the criteria imposed by the Indian authorities without prior notice.
- (c) Candidates after the receipt of placements cannot decline the scholarship except under a situation that the Higher Educational Institute concerned is not recognized by the University Grants Commission.
- (b) If any student declines the offer (except under the above c) after the selection through the interview, he/she will not be considered for any of the scholarships during the year.
- (d) Extension of the period of the scholarship will not be recommended by this Ministry.

06. Applications:

- (a) Each applicant should submit only one application.
- (b) Any statement in the application, which is found to be incorrect before selection, will render the applicant liable to disqualification. If such inaccuracy is found after selection it will lead to the withdrawal of the award.
- (c) Any application, which is incomplete in any respect or received late, will be rejected.

07. Nominations & Selections:

- (a) Nominations will be made through an interview after short listing of applications on the basis of the Z score obtained at the G.C.E A/L Examination. These nominations will be forwarded to the High Commission of India in Colombo.
- (b) As a result of the time period defined by the Government of India the interviews may be conducted within a short period after the closing date.
- (c) The final selections will be made by the Government of India as the awarding authority accordingly. Therefore, no candidate should treat his/her nomination for a scholarship as an acceptance for an award. Acceptance is a matter entirely within the discretion of the awarding authority.
- (d) Any form of canvassing either written or verbal will be considered as a disqualification for a scholarship.
